 inspect and approve your installation prior to DU
 turning on your Natural Gas service.

What are the benefits of Natural Gas?

Natural Gas is an economical alternative to electricity and propane gas which can be used for a variety of purposes including heating water, heating your home, drying clothes and cooking!

What is Natural Gas?

Natural gas is a natural energy source that forms deep beneath the earth's surface from fossils. It is a clear, odorless gas that is extracted from underground wells similar to those used to drill for oil.

How does Natural Gas get to my home?

Decatur Utilities purchases natural gas from multiple suppliers throughout the country. By having multiple suppliers, we are able to receive competitive pricing and pass those savings on to you!

We deliver Natural Gas to your home via a network of regulator stations and underground pipes. Your home has a "service line" that ties into the Natural Gas main line in front of your residence.

Outside your home, there is a meter that we use to measure how much Natural Gas you use each month. Past that meter, there are pipes inside your home that deliver Natural Gas to the appliances being fueled.

Natural Gas is lighter than air and will quickly disperse into the surrounding atmosphere. Propane is heavier than air and will settle to the ground where it can pose an explosive threat.

DU adds a distinctive "rotten egg" smell to Natural Gas so you can quickly identify a possible leak and evacuate to a safe area.

DU surveys its Natural Gas lines on a regular basis to identify and repair any leaks.

DU has aggressively replaced all cast iron piping on its Natural Gas system with more durable High-Density Polyethylene pipes.
